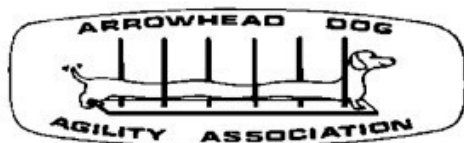

ENTRY FEES: \$18/RUN (includes the \$4.50 AKC recording fee for first entry and \$4.50 for subsequent entries).

PAYMENT METHODS: This trial is accepting entries by mail or online through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be 165 runs online and 165 runs paper each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, ADAA reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. With mail in entries we accept checks, money orders &/or ADAA vouchers – cash is not accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry & a charge of \$25 will be made for each returned check.

ENTRY FORMS: Entries received prior to opening date will not be accepted. Hand deliveries are accepted 24 hours after opening. Any changes or cancellations to mailed in entries MUST be done via email (akctralsecretaryadaa@gmail.com) to the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. If entries were through LabTestedOnline.com changes need to be made through them. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial closing date. No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

REFUNDS: Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded (less \$10 administrative fee/day) prior to the start of judging. Dogs injured after closing date will be refunded (less \$10 administrative fee/day) with a valid veterinary note and written notification received w/in 24 hours prior to the start of judging. There shall be **no refunds** for entries withdrawn after the closing date. **No** entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, public emergencies, an act of God, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees **shall not be refunded** in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Judge, or banned from competition by action of the trial committee. Refunds will not be given for refunds of \$5 or less.

ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

Dirt Floor Arena Complex 3300 N Boundary Avenue, Proctor, MN

From the South:

Take I 35 north to exit #249, Boundary Ave. Turn left, follow Boundary Ave. about 3 ½ miles until it ends. The South St. Louis County Fairgrounds are on the right side of the road.

From the North or from Wisconsin via Hwy 53:

Take I 35 south of Duluth to exit #250, Highway 2. Take Highway 2 north ½ mile to Boundary Ave. Turn Right, follow Boundary Ave. about 2 ½ miles until it ends. The South St. Louis County Fairgrounds are on the right side of the road.

From the Iron Range:

Take Highway 53 south to Midway Rd. in Pike Lake. Turn right, follow Midway Rd. to Highway 2. Turn Left, Follow Highway 2 south into Proctor. Turn Left onto Boundary Ave. Go about 2 ½ miles to the end of the Road. The South St. Louis County Fairgrounds are on the right side of the road.

****NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS****

RINGSIDE: The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog at the ringside when the class is to be judged. Judges are not required to wait for dogs and ADAA has no responsibility to provide services of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is ADAA's primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with, and able to, perform all obstacles safely. **Dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.**

LIABILITY: ADAA will **not** be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

WARM-UP AREA, consisting of a regulation jump will be provided for exhibitors.

ADAA agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

LEASHES: Effective January 1, 2022, leashes can be worn or put in pockets – now a part of Chapter 4, Section 10. Insert is available in the reference section.

MEASUREMENT: Effective August 1, 2022, all dogs that do not have a height card must be measured prior to the first run for the dog that day per Chapter 2, Section 5, Paragraph 5.

CRATING: Designated crating space will be available inside the building. Ex-pens are not allowed.

FOOD: Food and beverages will be provided for volunteers. There is a Kwik Trip and other food establishments close to the trial site.

RESTROOMS: Portable restrooms will be on site.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners listing number (if the trial-giving club is offering the option of Canine Partners entries. See front page of the premium for that information), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate if the trial-giving club is offering the option of mixed breed entries and provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not eligible to participate in agility trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$10.00 processing fee. To receive a refund notification must be given to the trial secretary PRIOR TO THE START OF JUDGING on the first day the bitch is entered.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO may be offered at the option of host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in T2B & FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

*FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

*Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

*Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

*The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
